A versatile major, Family Studies and Human Development prepares students for careers and graduate training in a variety of fields such as human services, social policy, community and public health, counseling, social work, medicine, nursing, occupational therapy, gerontology, child/ elder advocacy, criminal justice/law, and child life specialist professions. Students are encouraged to choose a minor in a career-related area. They may choose a minor outside of the department or opt to take courses in a chosen thematic minor carefully structured by students and their advisors, in order to prepare for specialized career paths or graduate school admission.

TRANSFER EQUIVALENCIES

The information presented is a recommended outline of courses for students to take at Maricopa Community Colleges that will transfer as equivalent courses to the University of Arizona. Please note that all course work will be officially evaluated once your official transcript is processed by the University of Arizona. Students must receive a grade of a C or higher for a course to transfer.



In Family Studies and Human Development, students will take classes such as dynamics of family relations; infancy and child development; issues in aging; prevention and treatment of problems in adult development and relations; and leadership, ethics, and professional practices to prepare them to enter the workforce after graduation or to go on to graduate school to work in industries such as counseling, social work, nursing, or occupational therapy.
